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When did zoom change from a verb to a noun we would hear in normal everyday speech? Recently for sure! The Church is using the Zoom software to handle many of our "face-to-face" interactions during this time. It's the next best thing.

You Need:     \_\_\_ A Computer or any device *with sound* that will connect to the internet  
                  \_\_\_ Earphones with microphone (recommended)  
                  \_\_\_ External speakers/external microphone (optional)

How to connect:     \_\_\_ Type in the website and click on the button in the top right to "sign up"  
                          \_\_\_ Create an account. The free version is perfect for most.  
                          \_\_\_ When a "meeting" is close to starting, click on the JOIN MEETING link in the email invitation you received from the group leader or the Church Office. The software does the rest.  
                          \_\_\_ Once you are in, check the bottom left of your screen to make sure your audio and video is on.

BE AWARE: If you are not using earphones and a microphone you will want to keep yourself muted until you have something to say. This helps reduce the background noises for everyone.

When using the Church Office zoom account please:

- \_\_\_ Designate a HOST for the meeting. This person will be able to:
  - \* Help unmute/mute people as needed.
  - \* END the meeting when you are done. (Very important so other groups after you can meet.)The host will be given a code to claim host functions.
- \_\_\_ Be sure to start and end on time. Only one group can use the software at one time, just like a room.

How to connect:    \_\_\_ Type in the address, and scroll down to find the message you are searching for.  
                          **You do not need to register with Facebook to see public page information.**

BE AWARE: You will not be able to type or hit any of the interaction buttons without an account.

## The Private Page

You Need:    \_\_\_ A Computer or any device *with sound* that will connect to the internet  
                  \_\_\_ External speakers (optional)

How to connect:    \_\_\_ Log in to (or create) your facebook account  
                          \_\_\_ In the top left blue search bar type "Ivy Memorial Friends and Family"  
                          \_\_\_ Select the group that most matches the search  
                          \_\_\_ Click on the button to "JOIN" the page. Approval can take up to 24 hrs.

This page is specifically for Ivy Friends and Family to share information that is usually not shared with the general public. You may see information posted to both pages that look similar but they will be slightly different because the audience is different.

BE AWARE: Photos should be shared to the PRIVATE page only. Please help us protect individual privacy concerns.

                          \_\_\_ Click the first link that shows number of subscribers and total number of videos.  
                          \_\_\_ Click on the Playlists tab to see the different groups of videos we have at the moment.

BE AWARE: Videos are uploaded regularly these days. You'll want to check in once in awhile to see what's new.
